Desired Results

Lesson goals:

Learning Daily Routine in Arabic.

Essential Questions:

- What do you do in the morning? What time do you do this?
- What do you do after school?

Lesson Objectives: *Students will be able to:*

2. Learn how to pronounce these sentences correctly.
1. Learn how to make a dialogue concerning these sentences.

Assessment Evidence

*Students can talk about different times of the day when they are shown the pictures of the PowerPoint Presentation and videos.

Learning Plan

Materials needed:

PowerPoint presentation – handouts - Videos

Learning activities:

I revise asking about the time and parts of the day in Arabic. I also revise greeting people in morning and evening in Arabic.

I ask students what they do in the morning. Then with pictures ,flashcards and gestures, I go through daily routine and ask them to repeat after me to pronounce the sentences correctly.

I show students a PowerPoint and two videos of different daily activities.

Students work in pairs, one ask “what do you do in the morning?” Another student replies “I wake up, wash my face, eat my breakfast and go to school”.
